SUBJECT: Command Policy Statement No. 6 – Environmental

 - d. Allocate depot resources and training to protect our environment and continually improve our environmental management system.
2. We will set goals and objectives in accordance with our ISO 14001:2004 and environmental policies and procedures. Proper environmental management and coordination at TEAD is not only necessary to comply with regulations and standards, it also benefits the overall mission by preventing time delays or operational shutdowns and improving public relations.
3. As an employee, you can help ensure TEAD remains a good steward of the environment and that your actions comply with regulations. You can and should discuss environmental issues with your supervisor and coworkers, and the Environmental Management Division if assistance is needed. The depot as a whole will do better environmentally and operationally if you will get involved and stay aware of environmental issues.
